Entries after that date will be accepted, range space permitting, subject to a £5.00 late entry fee

Note: We have increased the entry fees for all competitions but discontinued the former 'Registration fee'. Furthermore, Juniors receive a £5.00 and Members a £3.00 discount.
For most competitors the overall entry-fees are less than last year.

Junior Competitions are concurrent with the Championship events and may not be entered or competed separately.

No additional entry fees are payable. Certificates will be awarded to the top three places.

ALL CHAMPIONSHIP & JUNIOR TROPHIES WILL BE HELD BY THE WINNERS FOR 1 YEAR.

Open Championships

All comers are eligible for the Open Championships which are fired concurrently with the English Championships.

A Commemorative Shield will be awarded if the winner of an event is not an ESSU Member and therefore ineligible for the Championship medals or trophies. Certificates will be awarded to the top three places.

Medallists in the English Championships who are also in any of the top three places in the Open Championships will receive a Certificates of Merit.
